The Great Barrier Reef and the world's oldest rainforest are the ideal backdrop for our 51st Inner Wheel Australia National Conference. Their World Heritage values are closely linked with the oldest living culture on earth which can be experienced in these unique natural environments.

Snorkeling with turtles, swimming with whales and diving with giant potato cod are among the many ways to immerse yourself in the Great Barrier Reef. Stay dry with a scenic helicopter flight, glass-bottom boat tour or helmet dive. Try stand-up paddle boarding around an island, a massage on a reef pontoon or cocktails on a sand cay for the ultimate in relaxation.

Explore the world's oldest rainforest with an Indigenous guide showing you the foods and medicines used by rainforest Aboriginal people for tens of thousands of years. Swim beneath waterfalls, encounter a cassowary or snorkel down a river looking for platypus. Hide out in a luxurious rainforest lodge, zipline through the canopy or spot crocodiles on a river cruise.

More than 600 tours a day explore the Reef, Wet Tropics rainforest, accessible outback, beaches, mountains and farming hinterland of Cairns & Great Barrier Reef.

Cairns International Airport is the northern gateway to Australia and just 10 minutes from the city centre. Transport to the Cairns CBD is by taxi, uber or shuttle bus.

All delegates will feel at home the moment they step off the plane with a warm welcome from the Cairns Airport ambassadors who will greet you and provide any information required for a smooth transition from airport to your accommodation.
