



TOURS FOR FRIDAY 14th OCTOBER 2022.

1. Head for the Blue Mountains. Admire the incredible views of the Jamison Valley and Three Sisters from Echo Point lookout. Next, we visit Scenic World, the Scenic Railway where you can ride the world's steepest Scenic Railway, the Scenic Skyway and the Cableway (rides at your own expense). These thrilling rides offer unforgettable views of the Blue Mountains, including Katoomba Falls, the Three Sisters and beyond. Take a stroll along the boardwalks through the forest (and keep an eye out for the lyrebirds in the undergrowth!) and then stop for lunch at the Grand View Hotel at Wentworth Falls (lunch not included). The Grand View Hotel is located in Wentworth Falls Village, it was originally built in 1883 with a rich history going back to the pioneering days of the Blue Mountains. Finally stopping at the Blue Mountains Chocolate Company if there is time on the way home.

2. Travel to EBENEZER Church one of the oldest sites with many graves going back to the start of NSW; have a tour of the interesting graves; have morning tea of scones made by the ladies who caretake the site.
We then travel to TIZZANA winery where lunch is provided. Take a tour of the winery and sample some of the wines.

3. Walking tour of the Rocks. Travel by train to Circular Quay; join the walking tour; take in the sights around the Opera House where you can also see the magnificent Harbour Bridge and Lady Macquarie's Chair. Learn about the history and modern-day aspects of The Rocks, Sydney, on this exciting guided tour that takes guests around the area and entertains them with tales, sights, and living history.
Lunch at your own cost at one of the amazing cafes or pubs in The Rocks.

MINIMUM 15

COST:

Tour : \$35
