

#### Celebrating IIW Day in District 192 Austria and Czech Republic



Finally Inner Wheel Birthday cake and other delicious cakes that were waiting, prepared by friends from IWC Salzburg were cut and eaten.








# **Bangladesh**

Close to 200 members attended the Inner Wheel Day Celebration last January 7, 2023, held at the Alberione Hall, Society of Saint Paul Seminary in Makati City.

For five decades, the country celebrates this occasion with three major activities:

Tunay Na Atin (Buy locally made products) Bazaar, Ako Ay Pilipino (I am a Filipino) National Level Competition, and the Honoring of Past National Presidents. The Tunay Na Atin (Buy locally-made products) Bazaar aims to promote Philippine-made products and support the livelihood programs of the adopted communities of the Clubs from the nine districts.

The Ako Ay Pilipino (I am a Filipino) National Level Competition fosters nationalism among the youth through their active participation in community development and perception of the current events in the country. Grade 12 students from the nine districts compete in essay writing and oral interview. This year, Ms. Gilan Mae Fajardo from Nueva Ecjia High School and the representative from Inner Wheel Club of Cabanatuan, District 377 won the competition.
