Cowes, Phillip Island, Victoria



Cowes the place to be in 23

Located on one of Victoria's few north-facing beaches, Cowes, is Phillip Island's commercial hub, an ideal base to soak up the Island's seaside holiday vibe.

Cowes is the main township on Phillip Island in the Gippsland region of Victoria, Australia. The commercial centre of Cowes is lined with golden cypress trees and recognised by the National Trust of Australia. It caters well for the busy holiday crowds with a selection of restaurants, cafes, gift shops, hotels and supermarkets. Across the road from the commercial centre is attractive Cowes foreshore which consists of wide expanses of lawn shaded by a mixture of native and cypress trees, complete with BBQ areas, shelters and pathways. The sloping foreshore extends down to the clean golden sands of the beach, with the inviting waters popular with swimmers. On the beach, opposite the Commercial area, is the Cowes Jetty. An outdoor cafe is located at its entrance, while the T-shaped jetty structure is suitable for fishing and is the departure point for several ferries and tourist cruises.
