In memory of...

Val Walton was a past Member of IWC of Bendigo South, serving as President and other Club positions. She was Chairman for A60 in 2004-2005. When Bendigo South handed back its Charter, Val and 3 other Members joined IWC of Bendigo in 2014-15. Val stayed a Member till 2020, when her health declined because of cancer & she resigned but remained a Link Friend of the Club. Val passed away in mid-December, and we were told by her husband her wishes were that there was to be no public ceremony. When contacted on behalf of the Club, his wish was that we would honour Val at a meeting and I asked him to attend to speak. Colin donated \$100.00 on behalf of Val's strong commitment to Cord Blood Research and the Club decided to match his donation, totalling \$200.00.



The sum of \$2000 has been received from relatively new Gosford North Inner Wheel member Heather Coady. Heather has only been a member for a little while and when she found out about the Cord Blood project she wanted to make this donation as her husband Chris had passed from a form of blood cancer.

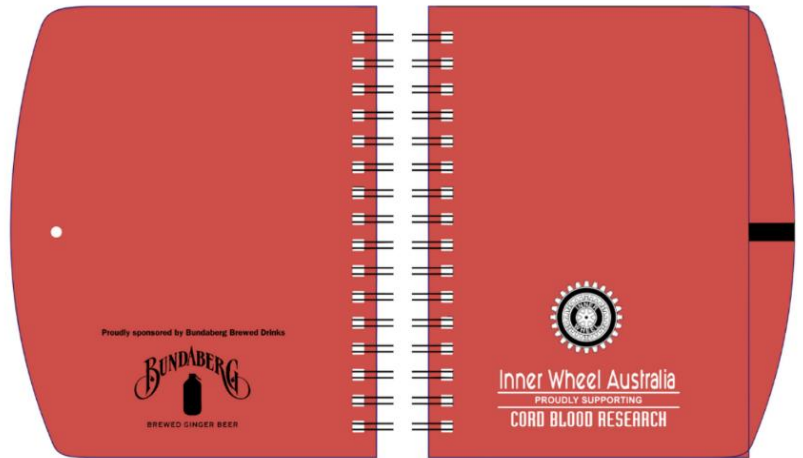
