When saving bank details, try to make it unique so that you will not confuse the details with another person or business. From my personal bank account, I transfer funds to my Inner Wheel Club, Inner Wheel District and Inner Wheel Australia conference accounts. In order NOT to get confused (although I have been known to do so from time to time) this is how I have set up my Inner Wheel contacts in my Bank:

- My IW Club, Trinity After Dark – Saved as TAD IWC - Reference I use is J Bennett
- My IW District, A76 – Saved as A76 IW - Reference I use is J Bennett TAD
- IW Conference accounts – I check the registration form as there are two – Reference for both accounts, is J Bennett TAD. These are the conference accounts: -
- Year of Conference 2025 – IWA Conf (Odd Year) – BSB 032539 Acc 489053
- Year of Conference 2026 – IWA Conf (Even Year) – BSB 032576 Acc 162930

Hope this helps anyone having trouble transferring funds to the correct account. And don't forget, please send an email to the Treasurer – Club, District or IWA to let them know that you have sent the funds.
